Although GPS does a better job of locating you relative to geographic features, RADAR reveals your position relative to other vessels, landmasses, buoys, etc.. that are in your immediate area. It can be used as an aid to navigation, especially in poor visibility, it can "see" at night, it can display shorelines and other geographic features, it can detect storm clouds and precipitation.

Included with the course is a CD with a RADAR simulator program. The simulator allows the student to practice the different features of RADAR units.
